Objective of the Eastern European Project

To train teams of citizens in Eastern European countries who will make Nonviolent Communication Training available within their countries.

Strategy for achieving this objective

- Identify people within Eastern European countries presently involved in providing Nonviolent Communication Training to determine the role they would like to play in the project.
- Identify people in each country who might be interested in organizing introductory workshops.
- Provide Introductory Workshops in each country, recruiting from the participants those who have ability and willingness to become trainers.
- Provide the level of training necessary for those identified as potential trainers so that they themselves can train people within their countries.

What has been done?

I have connections in Romania, Poland, and Croatia. We would like to achieve in these countries projects like those that have been created in Yugoslavia. There a team with several trainers has made NVC training available to over 30,000 school children.

Plans -- What is the next step?

To find at least 5-6 more people in different Eastern European countries who would enjoy helping to organize the local teams.
