### **Objective of the Poland Project**

To make Nonviolent Communication available to as many people as possible in Poland.

### **Achievements to date:**

Marshall has visited Poland twice, appearing on national Television, Radio and Press. His public workshops attracted over 500 people.

Publication of the Polish language translation of Marshall's book (February 2003).

There are now three active practice groups in Warsaw and we are offering training in Poland at least every 3 months (thanks to the support of Eva Rambala, Towe Widstrand and Marianne Gothlin).

### **Goals by the end of 2006**

- 4 certified trainers in Poland
- 10 active practice groups operating in Poland
- *NVC Workbook* and *Life Serving Education* published in Polish
- NVC included in the national teacher training curriculum
- First school established in Poland based on the principles of NVC
- NVC represented in National media at least every month
